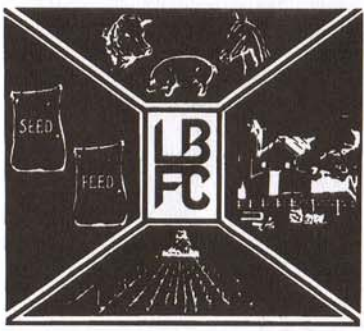

The times shown in this calendar are daylight saving time from the second Sunday in March until the first Sunday in November. They are based on a 35° latitude and a longitude of 75° Eastern Time Zone, 90° Central, 105° Mountain and 120° Pacific. Your local times for Sun r., Sun s., etc. can be figured approx. by adding 4 minutes for each degree you are west or subtracting 4 minutes for each degree you are east of the above degrees. Also add 2.9 minutes for each degree you are north or subtract 2.9 minutes for each degree you are south. Moon's phases and seasons calculated at 7:00 AM EST.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR JANUARY. 1st-3rd: Milder for the West, then light snows from the Rockies to Kansas and Nebraska. Snow for parts of the Southwest; rain for Texas. Possibly a few showers for the Tournament of Roses Parade. Light snow for the Great Lakes. Unsettled for the East, with possible rain and snow; Mummers Parade in Philly could be wet. **4th-7th:** Mostly fair weather prevails over the Western and Central States. California and much of the Southwest enjoy a spell of pleasant temperatures. Some light snow falls over the Ohio River east into New England, followed by clearing. Southern States are showery, especially central and south Florida. Mid-Atlantic is also wet. **8th-11th:** Severe Pacific disturbances move east through the Rockies, bringing a dose of heavy snow (8 to 12 inches) over the Plains into the Great Lakes. Stormy from the Southwest to the Mississippi River Valley. Generally fair over the Southeast; Georgia and Florida are mild. **12th-15th:** Rain and thunderstorms over the Gulf Coast and Southern States clear away to the east, followed by fair skies and milder weather. Stormy conditions over the Northeast, followed by fair skies. Mostly fair and bitterly cold for the West and the Central States. **16th-19th:** Showery with gusty winds along the Pacific Coast. Light snow for the Plains States into the Great Lakes and Northeast. Snow over the Southwest. Showers from Texas across the South into the Mid-Atlantic States; then clearing and very cold for the South, with frosts reaching down into Florida. **20th-23rd:** Pleasant (at first) West to Mississippi Valley, then turning unsettled in the Rockies, with snow from the Plains east through the Great Lakes. Chance of snow for the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast. Showery for the Southeast though Florida is mainly dry. **24th-27th:** A series of storms move from Texas across the Southeast, followed by fair and much colder conditions. Snow for the Northeast, followed by clearing. Blustery and very cold winds envelop much of the West. **28th-31st:** Fair West through Great Lakes, followed by wet weather. Showers from the Gulf Coast through the Mid-Atlantic.
