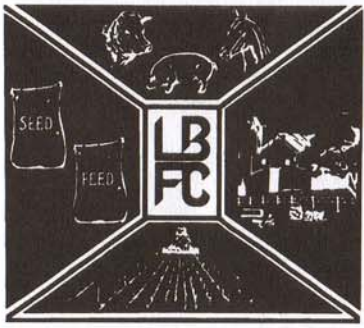

PLANTING TABLE FOR OCTOBER

GARDENS: Turnips, mustard, spinach, kale, rape, carrots, cabbage and collard plants, onion sets, smooth seeded English peas. **FLOWERS:** This is the month to begin planting hyacinths, tulips, jonquils, daffodils, crocus, sweet peas, larkspur, ragged robin, cosmos, poppies, annual phlox, pinks, candy tufts, pansies, violas, ageratum, stocks and petunia seeds.

The times shown in this calendar are daylight saving time from the second Sunday in March until the first Sunday in November. They are based on a 35° latitude and a longitude of 75° Eastern Time Zone, 90° Central, 105° Mountain and 120° Pacific. Your local times for Sun r., Sun s., etc. can be figured approx. by adding 4 minutes for each degree you are west or subtracting 4 minutes for each degree you are east of the above degrees. Also add 2.9 minutes for each degree you are north or subtract 2.9 minutes for each degree you are south. Moon's phases and seasons calculated at 7:00 AM EST.

- PISCES Watery, Fruitful, Feminine
- GEMINI Airy, Dry and Barren
- VIRGO Earthy, Dry or Barren, Feminine
- SCORPIO Watery, Fruitful, Feminine
- CANCER Watery, Very Fruitful, Feminine
- LIBRA Airy, Moist, Semi-Fruitful, Masculine
- SAGITTARIUS Fiery, Dry and Barren, Masculine

WEATHER FORECAST FOR OCTOBER. 1st-3rd: Fair for the Western and Central States. Also mostly fair for the Mississippi Valley and all points east. 4th-7th: Windy with a few scattered showers for California and Southwest. Stormy for much of the West, with some wet snow over the Rockies and flurries across the Plains. Wet through the Mississippi Valley. Windy but dry in the East. 8th-11th: Squally over Indiana and Ohio east. Heavy rains over the Southeast up to the Mid-Atlantic States. Stormy, with gale-force winds, along the New England coast. All of these regions will clear by the 11th. Elsewhere, fair and cold. 12th-15th: Turning unsettled in the West to Ohio and Kentucky, followed by clearing. Showers reach New York and Pennsylvania, then through the Northeast by the end of this period, accompanied by milder air. Chilly rains from the Gulf Coast north through the Carolinas. 16th-19th: Stormy from the Pacific Coast through Utah and Colorado. Windy and rainy for the Southwest. Heavy rains spread into the Central States. Squalls for the Great Lakes. Dry, milder weather for New England. 20th-23rd: Rain and thunderstorms from Texas to the Mid-Atlantic States; severe thunderstorms roll through Indiana and Ohio into the Northeast; all followed by clearing and unseasonable cold down into the Southeast. Clearing skies and colder for the West into the Mississippi Valley. 24th-27th: Fair for Western and Central States initially, then turning unsettled as far east as the Great Lakes and Northeast by the 27th. Light rains for Texas and the Southeast. 28th-31st: Looks wet for the trick-or-treaters over the West. Starting off pleasant over the Southern Plains, then turning stormy and colder along the West Coast from Washington and Oregon south through California and east into the Rockies. Mississippi Valley and all points east are dry and fair.
