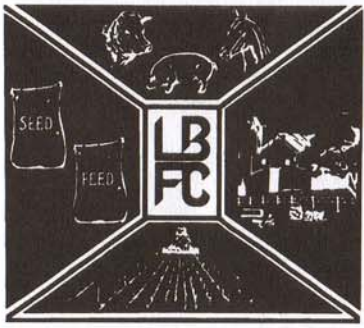

LAWNS: This is one of the best months of the year to build old, plant new lawns. Blue grass, evergreen mixtures, shady place grass and winter green and ryegrass should be planted to give perfect results. Also add 2.9 minutes for each degree you are north or subtract 2.9 minutes for each degree you are south. WEATHER FORECAST FOR SEPTEMBER. 1st-3rd: Labor Day weekend looks showery for Western and Central States, followed by clearing. Scattered showers from Texas across Southeast up to the Mid-Atlantic States, some thunderstorms. Wet weather for New England. **4th-7th:** Fair weather deteriorates over the West, stormy for Washington and Oregon. Squalls over the Rockies. Threatening skies over the Southwest. Pleasant Nebraska and Dakotas east to New England. Hot and oppressively humid over the Southeast. **8th-11th:** Hurricane threat along the Gulf Coast. Heavy thunderstorms for Texas and Southeast. Also thunderstorms across the Plains States through the Mississippi Valley into New England, followed by clearing. The West is fair. **12th-15th:** Mostly fair for the Western and Central States, then unsettled weather spreads east from the coast into Utah, Colorado. Fair skies for the Mississippi Valley. Hurricane threat for the eastern seaboard. **16th-19th:** Rain falls over the Plains east through the Great Lakes into the Northeast, then turning fair and cooler. A tropical disturbance dawdles off the East Coast. Showery across the Southeast, then clearing. Pleasant, tranquil weather for the West. **20th-23rd:** Unsettled for West Coast. Severe thunderstorms race rapidly east from Rocky Mountains across the Plains into the Great Lakes; possible tornadoes for Oklahoma, Kansas. Tropical "drownpours" over the Southeast. Fair for the Northeast. **24th-27th:** Squalls over Texas sweep across the Southeast, followed by fair, chilly weather. Brisk winds for the West and Plains States. Thunderstorms rapidly rumble over the Ohio River east, followed by clearing and colder conditions. **28th-30th:** Fair for the Northeast, followed by scattered rain showers. Unsettled again over Texas and the Southeast. Unsettled in the West, with even some wet snowflakes over the highest areas of Idaho and Montana. Squally for the Plains States through the Great Lakes.
